**\*\* Hunt Rules \*\***

- Only Hunt Officials are allowed on hunt field before or after a hunt.
- Only Hunt Officials and Contestants are allowed on the hunt field during a hunt.
- Contestants must use the equipment they entered the field with, unless ok'd by an official.
- Contestants must use headphones during the hunt.
- Metal detector coils are limited to 11 inches maximum.
- No pin pointers allowed.
- No pulse induction metal detectors
- Hunt Official's rulings are final

**Camping Information:** The Radersburg BLM OHV Intensive Use area is adjacent to our claim sites, and has parking, primitive camping and an outhouse. Most attendants dry camp here, free of charge. This is a primitive campsite with no water.

**Motel Information:** Helena and Townsend are northwest of our site. Three Forks is Southeast. All communities have motels rooms and other modern connivances. Please check maps and directions below.

**Concessions:** A free-will donation lunch will be served between the Claim Jumper Hunt and Silver Coin Hunt. Any remaining campers usually have a potluck dinner after the hunt.

**Directions From Interstate 90 at Three Forks Montana:** Take exit 274, travel north on US 287, 19.4 miles. Turn west, (left) at the Bunkhouse Bar onto Highway 285. Travel 9.2 miles to Radersburg. Turn southwest (left) on Mill Street, go 1 mile to the cattle guard. Hunt ground and chapter claim is 100 feet past the cattle guard. Registration table and concessions are slightly further at the BLM OHV staging area.

This agreement includes the trip to and from the actual location of the outing.

This document applies to any and all prospecting and treasure hunting trips taken through the *Headwaters Chapter of the Gold Prospectors Association of America*. It applies not only to the date of signature, but to any and all future dates. This document will be in effect until and unless written revocation is received.
